SYNOPSIS	A resolution to approve the Cooper Orbit Relocation Project.
FISCAL IMPACT	\$105,722.00 in accordance with the signed Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Little Rock, Pulaski County, and Woodland Hills Valley, The amount includes 20% Construction Contingency for the proposed alignment of Cooper Orbit Road and Kanis Road. Funding will come from the Street Fund Special Projects, or another funding source as deemed appropriate and approved by the City.
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.
BACKGROUND	As part of the Woodlands Valley Subdivision Development, a segment of Cooper Orbit Road will be relocated to connect into existing Panther Branch Drive. By a previously signed Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Little Rock, Pulaski County, and Woodland Hills Valley, LLC, all parties agreed to participate in sharing the construction cost of relocating a segment of Cooper Orbit Road to Panther Branch Drive and closing down a segment of Cooper Orbit Road from Kanis Road to Panther Branch Drive, which will improve traffic operations in the area.
