3 A RESOLUTION TO SET JANUARY 17, 2017, AS THE DATE OF A
4 PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ABANDONMENT OF A THIRTY (30)-FOOT
5 WIDE ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF
6 BLOCK 4, DEAF MUTE ADDITION (G-23-464), IN THE CITY OF LITTLE
7 ROCK, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

9 WHEREAS, a petition has been filed to abandon a portion of alley right-of-way within the
10 corporate limits of the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, and Ark. Stat. Ann. § 14-301-303 (West 2004)
11 mandates that a public hearing be held before such abandonment takes place so any affected property owner
12 is given the chance to address the Board of Directors;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
14 CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

15 Section 1. On January 17, 2017, at 6:00 PM, or as soon thereafter as the item is reached upon the
16 agenda, a public hearing shall be held on the question of whether to abandon a thirty (30)-foot wide alley
17 right-of-way located along the west side of Block 4, Deaf Mute Addition, classified as item No. G-23-464
18 by the Little Rock Planning & Development Department.

19 Section 2. *Severability.* In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
20 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
21 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
22 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
23 resolution.

24 Section 3. *Repealer.* All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
25 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
