BACKGROUND	Residents in the vicinity of the property and those passing by have complained that the structure is a public nuisance and a danger to the health and safety of persons in the area and their property.

The City has contacted the owners by Certified and Regular Mail outlining the conditions of the structure, and they have failed to meet the timelines to either repair or demolish the structure.
