

1 to endorse the extension of this contract for an additional year utilizing Prevention, Intervention and
2 Treatment Funds.

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**
4 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

5 **Section 1.** The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a twelve (12)-
6 month contract extension agreement with Lessons Learned, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred
7 Sixty-Nine Thousand, Six Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$169,670.00), to provide Community Violence
8 Reduction Services.

9 **Section 2.** Funds for this program are available in Prevention, Intervention and Treatment Funds,
10 Account No.108159-S15C505.

11 **Section 3.** The term for such contract shall be for a period no longer than twelve (12) months to
12 begin on or about October 3, 2023, through September 30, 2024, with a final report due October 31, 2024;
13 further, the City ratifies, accepts and will compensate any work done between October 3, 2023, and the
14 effective date of any approved and executed contract in a form acceptable to the City Attorney as to legal
15 form.

16 **Section 4.** All payments are conditioned upon entry into a contract for services; further, nothing in
17 this resolution limits the ability of the City, in its sole discretion, to procure similar services from another
18 vendor during the term of the contract authorized here.

19 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
20 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
21 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and
22 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
23 resolution.

24 **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, including but not
25 limited to Little Rock, Ark. Resolution No. 15,518 (August 3, 2021), Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No.
26 15,629 (February 15, 2022) and Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,888 (February 7, 2023) that are
27 inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
