24	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Rush Truck Centers of		
25	Arkansas, for the purchase of two (2) 2024 International Model HV513 Chassis Trucks with Dump Beds		
26	in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand, Seven Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars		
27	(\$373,788.00), plus applicable taxes and fees, to be used by the Public Works Department Street Operations		
28	Division.		
29	Section 2. Funds for this agreement are available in Public Works Special Projects Account No.		
30	205409-72300-S40B646.		
31	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
