<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Approval of an amendment to Ordinance No. 21,729 to increase the amount of the first extension of the contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc., for the City's Radio Infrastructure Equipment utilized by the Communications Division.</p> <p>The increase amount is from \$142,139.05 to \$151,513.28, and funds for this purchase are allocated in the Little Rock Police Department's 911 Fund, Account No. 220512-61350.</p> <p>Approval of the ordinance.</p> <p>Ordinance No. 21,729 was passed by the Board of Directors on May 21, 2019, and allowed for a Sole-Source Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc., for repairs and maintenance on existing portable and mobile radios used across many City Departments. The Little Rock Police Department successfully utilized the Maintenance Plan in the contract for the Radio Infrastructure System which includes maintenance on dispatch center consoles, Mach Alert hardware, microwave links, and the radio IP logger which is utilized by the Communications Division.</p>

When exercising the option to extend the contract, it was determined that it was necessary to upgrade the Service Agreement which resulted in a higher cost than allowed by Ordinance No. 21,729.
