<p>SYNOPSIS</p> <p>FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>CITIZEN PARTICIPATION</p> <p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Approval of an ordinance to dispense with the requirement of competitive bidding and to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Zero RPM to sell to them one (1) 2013 Dodge Charger Police vehicle, for the amount of \$18,500.00, as there are exceptional circumstances regarding the sale of this vehicle to Zero RPM as a sole-source purchaser.</p> <p>Funds from the sale of this vehicle will be placed in the Fleet Replacement Fund Account.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>N/A</p> <p>This 2013 Dodge Charger Police vehicle was used as a test unit for the installation of Zero RPM Idle Mitigation equipment; however, the installation of that equipment required significant modifications. Due to these modifications, the vehicle is now unsafe, and irreparable as determined by the selling dealer; therefore, Zero RPM has agreed to purchase the vehicle from the City of Little Rock for an amount of \$18,500.00.</p>
