

1 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any title, subtitle, section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,
2 subparagraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or work of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid
3 or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the
4 ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or
5 unconstitutional was not originally a part of this ordinance.

6 **Section 5. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions, and parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
7 the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

8 **Section 6. Emergency Clause.** The Board of Directors of the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, has
9 determined that with development in the area covered by the boundaries of the Improvement District laid
10 off in this ordinance requires, as critical to the public health, safety, and welfare, construction of additional
11 infrastructure; an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and
12 effect from and after the date of its passage.
