



1 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the  
2 ordinance.

3 **Section 4. Repealer.** All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this ordinance are  
4 hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

5 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The necessity of appropriate procedures to follow in order to obtain*  
6 *a permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages that complies with state statutes and regulations, and which*  
7 *is stated in a way acceptable to the ABC is essential to the public health, safety and welfare, because it*  
8 *provides a means for the ABC to undertake its appropriate enforcement, administrative, permitting duties;*  
9 *this ordinance cannot proceed until such language is in place; therefore, an emergency declared to exist*  
10 *and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
