| BACKGROUND | <p>Earlier this year, the City applied for and was successful in being awarded a Historic Restoration Preservation Grant from the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program. The total amount of the grant is \$156,425.00, with \$55,825.00 being used for Consultants' Services for Phase II of the Hillcrest National Register of Historic Places District Resurvey and \$600.00 to be used for travel expenses to Arkansas Historic Preservation Program sponsored or approved trainings for Historic District Commissioners and Staff</p> | |

**BACKGROUND
CONTINUED**

\$100,000.00 of the grant funds is reserved for emergency repairs for the Pike-Fletcher-Terry House; however, since this property is currently the subject of litigation (*Susan Borné, et al. v. the City of Little Rock, et al.* (60CV-21-6690)), a separate resolution of intent shall come before the Board regarding the acceptance of these funds for the Pike-Fletcher-Terry House.
