<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	A resolution to adopt the Central Arkansas Regional Safety Action Plan, as approved by the Metroplan Board of Directors and to adopt a Vision Zero Policy, which includes reducing traffic deaths and serious injuries by 40% by 2040, while working toward the goal of eliminating all traffic deaths and serious injuries within the City of Little Rock, Arkansas.
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	None.
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	Approval of the resolution.
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>The Metroplan Board of Director has approved a Central Arkansas Regional Safety Action Plan, which has been developed to help local governments within the Central Arkansas Region to apply for Safe Streets for All Implementation Grants.</p> <p>The Safe Streets for All Implementation Grant Application requires that local governments pass a resolution adopting the Regional Safety Action Plan and a Vision Zero Policy.</p>
