

1 **Section 1.** The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with
2 Safety National Casualty Corporation to provide Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance to the City for
3 one (1)-year, effective July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, for a premium of Two Hundred Sixty-One
4 Thousand, Four Hundred One Dollars (\$261,401.00).

5 **Section 2.** Funding for the renewal is allocated annually in the City's General Fund Budget line items
6 for Workers' Compensation, Account No. 100000-14010.

7 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
8 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
9 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution, which shall remain in full force and
10 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
11 resolution.

12 **Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this
13 resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
