<p><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>An ordinance to approve amendments to Little Rock Code § 5-72(a) to eliminate the requirement that MEMS carry an Uninsured Motorist Policy and to replace the requirement of a \$1,000,000 Policy with \$1,000,000 Aggregate Coverage.</p> <p>None; MEMS shall pay for all of its insurance coverage.</p> <p>Approval of the ordinance.</p> <p>Due to claims, some of which are currently being contested, MEMS is facing a 61% increase in it insurance premiums. In its history, MEMS has never reached the limits of its insurance coverage, and they cannot continue to maintain its current insurance coverage and adequately provide emergency medical health services to the persons in its service area.</p>
