

1 tract may be extended for up to two (2) additional one (1)-year terms or a portion; and the effective date
2 of any approved and executed contract shall be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney as to legal form.

3 **Section 4.** All payments are conditioned upon entry into a contract for services; further, nothing in
4 this resolution limits the ability of the City, in its sole discretion, to procure similar services from another
5 vendor during the term of the contract authorized here.

6 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
7 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
8 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and
9 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
10 resolution.

11 **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
12 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
