



1       **WHEREAS**, in order to implement this portion of the activities to be funded by the Community  
2 Schools Model, the City will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with LRSD.

3       **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**  
4 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

5       **Section 1.** The Mayor and City Manager are authorized to are execute any necessary documents and to  
6 take any actions, as approved by the City Attorney, necessary to implement all parts of the Byrne Criminal  
7 Justice Innovation Program grant awarded by the United States Department of Justice to the City of Little  
8 Rock to provide services at Stephens Elementary School, the Stephens Community Center and the  
9 community they serve including, but not limited to, entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with  
10 the Little Rock School District to provide two (2) Social Workers for this project.

11       **Section 2. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
12 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
13 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and  
14 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
15 resolution.

16       **Section 3. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with  
17 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
