

1 **Section 3.** This contract may be extended for two (2) additional one (1)-year periods by mutual
2 consent of the parties; provided if there is less than a 20% change in the cost of the agreement for any one
3 (1)-year period, the City Manager may authorize the extension of the agreement if, in doing so, a
4 memorandum of this action is sent to the Mayor and members of the Board of Directors of such action, to
5 the Finance Director, to the Human Resources Director, and to the City Attorney; provided further, that in
6 no event shall such a contract extend past July 31, 2020.

7 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
8 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
9 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
10 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
11 ordinance.

12 **Section 5. Repealer.** All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this ordinance are
13 hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not limited to, Little Rock, Ark.,
14 Ordinance No. 21,444 (July 5, 2017).
