ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

18 Section 6. Emergency. The ability to regulate proper land use and zoning is essential to the public 19 health, safety and welfare, and further, requires an appropriate and consistent fee structure. An emergency 20 is therefore declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after January 1,

21 *2019*.
