

1 Health Professions' School of Counseling, Human Performance & Rehabilitation's undergraduate Health
2 Education & Promotion Internship (Institution), entered into a Memorandum of Understanding to
3 memorialize the collaboration of the parties with respect to a continuation of the City's LYS Initiative in
4 support of the goal of reducing childhood obesity in K-5 elementary schools within the Little Rock
5 School District and the Institution's undergraduate Health Education and Promotion Internship to provide
6 high quality community service and hands-on learning experiences through LYS for undergraduate
7 Education, Nursing, and Health Education & Promotion internship students enrolled at the University of
8 Arkansas at Little Rock; and,

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding, the Institution provided student
10 interns to serve as LYS Coordinators at up to eight (8) designated elementary schools in the Little Rock
11 School District in order to assist the City with the City's LYS Initiative; and,

12 **WHEREAS**, the City and Institution have evaluated the services provided under this initial
13 Memorandum of Understanding and now desire to conduct a Love Your School Pilot Project whereby the
14 City, the Institution and the Little Rock School District will enter into a sole source Memorandum of
15 Understanding for one (1)-year in the furtherance of the LYS initiative.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**
17 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

18 **Section 1.** The Board of Directors finds that a competitive selection process should be dispensed
19 with and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a one (1)-year sole-source Memorandum of
20 Understanding with the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas and the Little Rock School
21 District as follows:

22 A. The University of Arkansas – Little Rock: Funds required for up to thirty-six (36) student
23 interns to execute the Love Your School Pilot Project during the 2016-2017 Winter-Spring
24 Term (January 2017 through May 2017) and the 2017-2018 Fall Term (Mid-August 2017
25 through Mid-December, 2017), in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Ten Thousand,
26 Two Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$110,216.00);

27 B. Little Rock School District Partner Schools: Funds required to execute the Love Your
28 School Pilot Project during the 2016-2017 Winter-Spring Term (January 2017 through May
29 2017) and the 2017-2018 Fall Term (Mid-August 2017 through Mid-December, 2017), in an
30 amount not to exceed One Hundred Eleven Thousand, Four Hundred Ten Dollars
31 (\$111,410.00).

32 **Section 2.** Funding for these services is available from Account Number 108129-S10A770.

1 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
2 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
3 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
4 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
5 ordinance.

6 **Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with
7 any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
