<p>SYNOPSIS</p> <p>FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Approval of a resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Manager to enter into a Public Services Agreement with Cammack Village to provide 911 Emergency Dispatch Services for a period of six (6) years with an option for two (2) renewal terms of one (1)-year each.</p> <p>Cammack Village to pay \$13,130.00, plus its 911 Turn Back Fees annually in exchange for Emergency Dispatch Services.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>Cammack Village is an unincorporated town without sufficient personnel to provide 911 Emergency Dispatch Services. The City entered into a similar Public Services Agreement with Cammack Village on March 5, 2019, via Resolution No. 14,952. That agreement has expired and Cammack Village and the City seeks to enter into a new, similar contract.</p>
