

1 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
2 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
3 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
4 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
5 ordinance.

6 **Section 4. Repealer.** All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this ordinance are
7 hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not limited to, Little Rock, Ark.,
8 Ordinance No. 21,954 (January 19, 2021).

9 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The necessity to obtain a permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages*
10 *that complies with State Statutes and Regulations, and which is stated in a way acceptable to the ABC is*
11 *essential to the public health, safety and welfare, because it provides a means for the ABC to undertake*
12 *its appropriate enforcement, administrative, permitting duties; this ordinance cannot proceed until such*
13 *language is in place; therefore, an emergency declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force*
14 *and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
