



1 times in one (1)-year increments, with the right to terminate the agreement upon completion of the  
2 Federally-Funded Housing Programs.

3 **Section 2.** The recommended sources for funding and uses are from the City’s 2017-2018 HUD  
4 Entitlement Funds.

5 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
6 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
7 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and  
8 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
9 resolution.

10 **Section 4. Repealer.** Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS All laws, ordinances, resolutions,  
11 or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the  
12 extent of such inconsistency.
