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<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">CITIZEN PARTICIPATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute a Fire Protection Services Agreement with the Pulaski County Fire Protection District Number 2 for fire protection services and hazardous materials incident response for Cammack Village for a term of ten (10) years.</p> <p>The Pulaski County Fire Protection District Number 2 shall remit \$10,500 per annum for each year this agreement is extended.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The Fire Protection Services Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the Pulaski County Fire Protection District Number 2 and the Cammack Village City Council.</p> <p>In 2007 the Little Rock Fire Department (LRFD) entered into an agreement with the Pulaski County Fire Protection District Number 2 to provide fire protection services and hazardous materials incident response to Cammack Village. Since this agreement was entered into Cammack Village has dissolved the Volunteer Fire Department and is reliant upon LRFD for fire protection services for the safety and wellbeing of their citizens.</p>
