



1       **Section 2.** The Insurance Broker shall maintain appropriate records of the negotiations that will  
2 become the property of the City and, to the extent permitted by law, will be subject to disclosure as a public  
3 record pursuant to the Arkansas Freedom of Information Act so long as such disclosure does not create an  
4 unfair competitive advantage for the insurance company.

5       **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, subtitle, section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,  
6 subparagraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or work of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid  
7 or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance  
8 which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitu-  
9 tional was not originally a part of this ordinance.

10       **Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with the  
11 provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

12       **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The ability to review the largest possible market for insurance prod-*  
13 *ucts to provide to City employees that are in the best overall interests of the City in terms of coverage and*  
14 *cost is essential to the public health, safety, and welfare; an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist and*  
15 *this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
