**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE A CONTRACT INCREASE FOR GENE SUMMERS CONSTRUCTION, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$29,515.00), FOR ADDITIONAL IMPROVEMENTS TO 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET, FROM PEYTON STREET TO WASHINGTON STREET; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS,** on April 17, 2018, the City of Little Rock Board of Directors authorized a contract with Gene Summers Construction, Inc., by Resolution Number 14,762, for 18<sup>th</sup> Street Improvements, Project No. 16-1-ST-8, Bid No. 18008; and,

**WHEREAS,** it is desirable to increase the authorized contract amount for Gene Summers Construction, Inc., to provide for the replacement of a sanitary sewer with the street reconstruction work.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to increase the contract amount for Gene Summers Construction, Inc., to One Hundred Four Thousand, Nine Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$104,947.00), which is an increase of Twenty-Nine Thousand, Five Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$29,515.00) from the original authorized amount as set forth in Resolution No. 14,762.

**Section 2.** Funding for this increase is to be reimbursed by the Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority as part of a cooperative agreement.

**Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

**Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
