| <p>SYNOPSIS</p> <p>FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>BACKGROUND</p> | <p>The Historic Hillcrest District of Downtown Little Rock is seeking Board approval to extend a Temporary Entertainment District to support outdoor dining areas not adjacent to the associated restaurant facility.</p> <p>None.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The City of Little Rock received an application for the Historic Hillcrest District on June 7, 2021. The boundaries of the Temporary Entertainment District start by North Monroe Street and goes east to Walnut Street. It also includes Beechwood Street, between Kavanaugh Boulevard and Woodlawn Drive, and North Palm Street, between Beechwood Street and F Street.</p> <p>This application sets the time frame for the Temporary Entertainment District to start August 5, 2021, and end on October 7, 2021. The dates and times are August 5, 2021, from 4:00 PM – 9:00 PM; September 2, 2021, from 4:00 PM – 9:00 PM; and October 7, 2021, from 4:00 PM – 9:00 PM.</p> | |
