14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY

16	SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for Burkhalter		
17	Technologies, Inc., for the project Hawthorne Street/Tyler Street Drainage Improvements Project in an

19	Dollars (\$279,933.60), which is the base bid amount of Two Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand, Two		
20	Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$233,278.00), plus 20% contingencies.		
21	SECTION 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and		
22	Compensating Use Tax Funds as authorized by Resolution No. 13,699.		
23	SECTION 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,		
24	or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
25	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
26	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the		
27	resolution.		
28	SECTION 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent		
29	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.		
30	SECTION 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.
