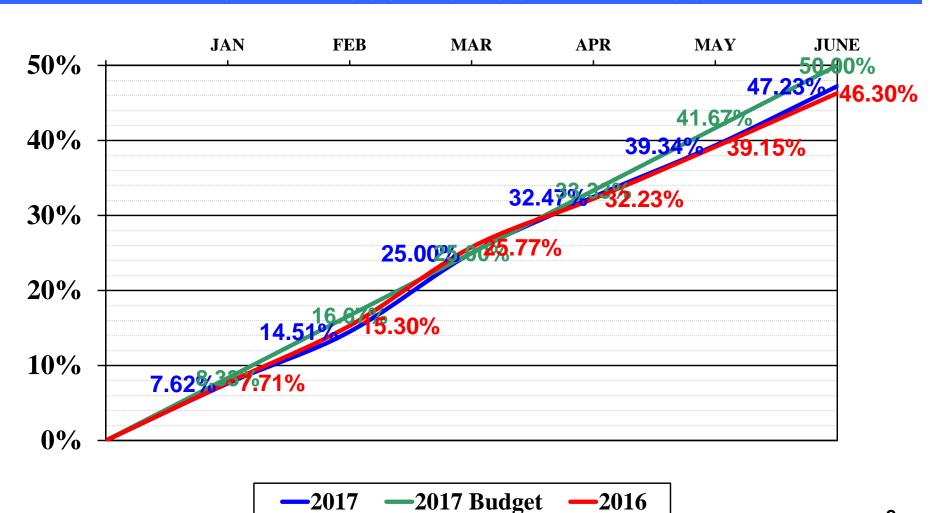

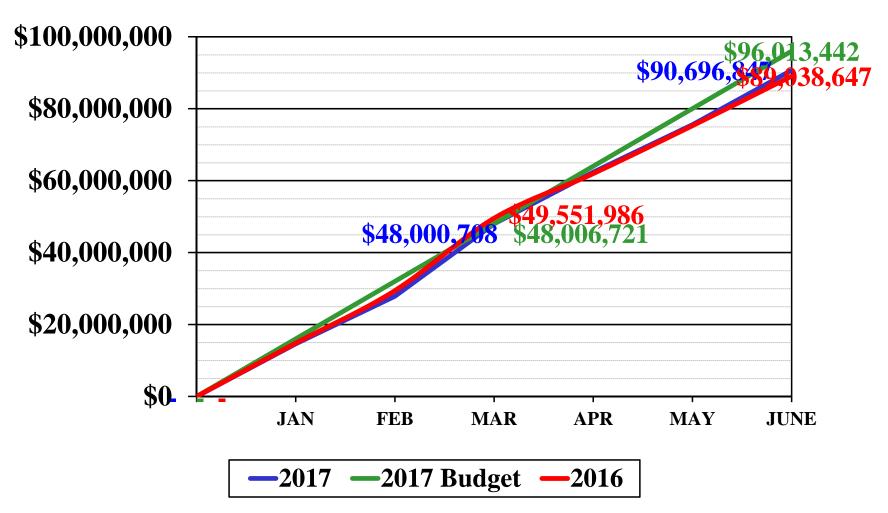
### **GENERAL FUND** REVENUES

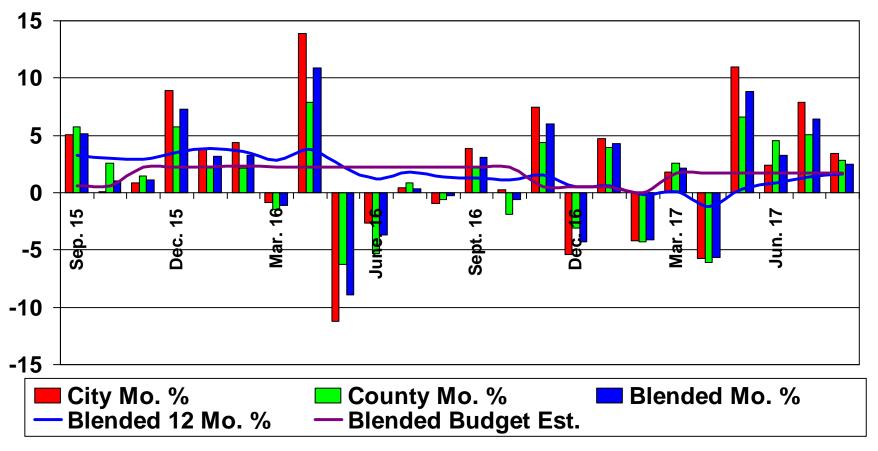
Revenues are approximately \$5.3 million below 1/2<sup>th</sup> of the adopted budget and approximately \$1.65 million above the same period a year ago. Revenue variances are primarily associated with the timing of collection and the commitment of first Franchise Fee and Park revenues to debt service on bond issues. Intergovernmental revenues are received annually in July.

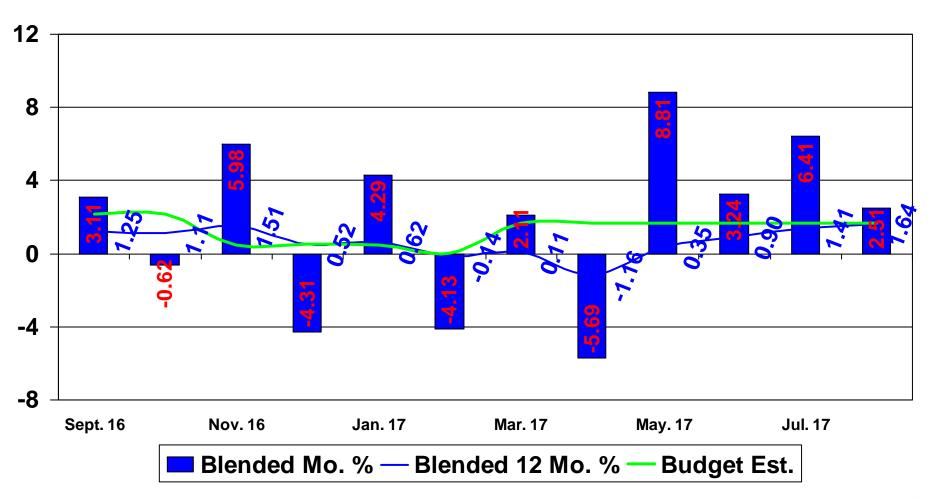
### CITY, COUNTY, AND BLENDED SALES TAX PERCENTAGE GROWTH

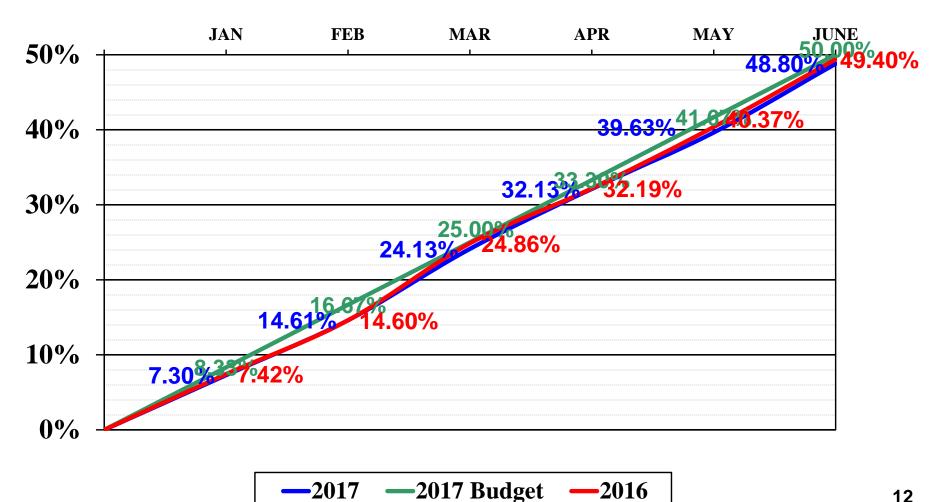

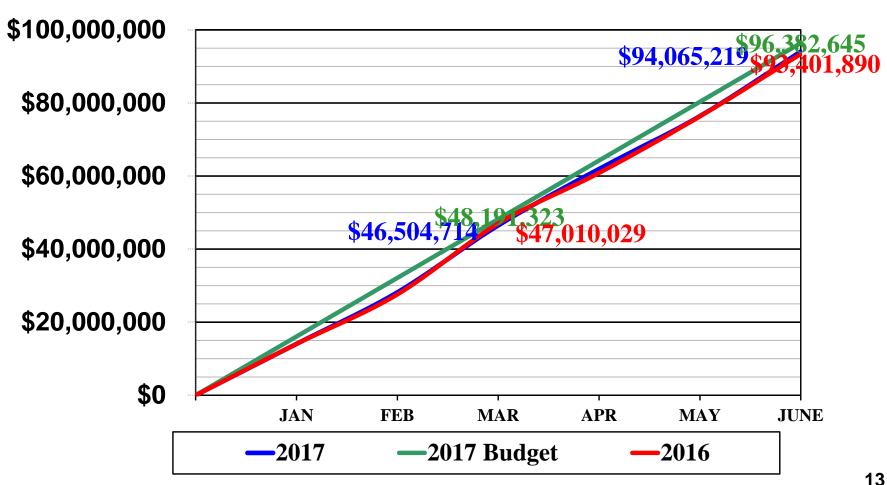
