SYNOPSIS	The City of Little Rock currently has a contract with Wright, Lindsey & Jennings, LLP (the "Firm") for legal consulting services for the City's solar energy project which will expire December 31, 2024, and is in need of renewal.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The renewed contract is in an amount not to exceed \$45,000 and will be paid from funds budget for this purpose in 2025 in Account 101001-63390.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	The City of Little Rock has completed the necessary interconnection agreements with Entergy for a 4.9 megawatt AC solar project. Thus, the city can take advantage of favorable net-metering rules that credit the city for the amount of electricity produced at the same rate as the electricity consumed. The City will receive a 40% rebate to offset a substantial portion of project costs following the first year of its operation. Construction is the next phase. To date the Firm has provided invaluable guidance in this \$12 million dollar project and their services will be needed through the completion of this project.
