<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>The City of Little Rock currently has a contract with Wright, Lindsey &amp; Jennings, LLP (the “Firm”) for legal consulting services for the City’s solar energy project which will expire December 31, 2024, and is in need of renewal.</p>	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	<p>The renewed contract is in an amount not to exceed \$45,000 and will be paid from funds budget for this purpose in 2025 in Account 101001-63390.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>The City of Little Rock has completed the necessary interconnection agreements with Entergy for a 4.9 megawatt AC solar project. Thus, the city can take advantage of favorable net-metering rules that credit the city for the amount of electricity produced at the same rate as the electricity consumed. The City will receive a 40% rebate to offset a substantial portion of project costs following the first year of its operation. Construction is the next phase. To date the Firm has provided invaluable guidance in this \$12 million dollar project and their services will be needed through the completion of this project.</p>
