**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ALL SERVICE ELECTRIC, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED NINETY-ONE THOUSAND, THIRTEEN DOLLARS AND 10/100 (\$391,013.10), FOR THE CHENAL CLUB INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, it has been deemed appropriate and necessary to analyze and design improvements to the intersection of Chenal Parkway at Chenal Club Boulevard; and,

**WHEREAS**, project improvements will construct and install a new traffic signal system and related work at the intersection of Chenal Parkway and Chenal Club Boulevard; and,

**WHEREAS**, bids were solicited for Chenal Club Intersection Improvement Project, Bid #2731; and

**WHEREAS**, All Service Electric, Inc. was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of one (1) bid received; and,

**WHEREAS**, the total cost for this contract shall not exceed Three Hundred Ninety-One Thousand, Thirteen Dollars and 10/100, (\$391,013.10), which is the base bid amount of Three Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Forty Four Dollars and 25/100, (\$325,844.25) plus a Twenty percent (20%) contingency; and,

**WHEREAS**, Funding for this project is from the 2022 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution 15,968 (May 2, 2023) with funds available from Account Activity B5D043S;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with All Service Electric, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Ninety-One Thousand, Thirteen Dollars and 10/100, (\$391,013.10), which is the base bid amount of Three Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Forty Four Dollars and 25/100, (\$325,844.25) plus a Twenty percent (20%) contingency.

**SECTION 2.** Funding for this project is from the 2022 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution 15,968 (May 2, 2023). Account Activity B5D043S.

**SECTION 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and

1 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the  
2 resolution.

3 **SECTION 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent  
4 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
