SYNOPSIS	The Resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into contracts with each wrecker service company that responded successfully to the City's Request for Qualifications.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The City charges a contract fee of 15% of all gross revenue collected pursuant to each non-consent towing service contract.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	In response to the City's Request for Qualifications for inclusion in the Little Rock Communications non-consent towing rotation, six companies submitted qualifications packets that met all of the City's requirements: Adams Towing, Asher Wrecker Service, East End Towing, Towco Investments (d/b/a JHook Towing and Recovery), Metro Towing & Recovery, and Pinnacle Towing & Recovery (d/b/a Routh Wrecker Service). As provided in the RFQ, the term of each of these contracts may be renewed two (2) times in one (1)-year increments if the City and the respective towing company agrees.
