SYNOPSIS	The applicant requests to abandon the twenty (20) foot wide (east/west) platted alley Right-of-Way (twenty (20) feet by 164 feet), located within Block 8, Woodruff's Addition (block bounded by E. 7 <sup>th</sup> , E. 8 <sup>th</sup> , College and McLean Streets), in the City of Little Rock.

BACKGROUND	The owner of all abutting properties requests to abandon the Twenty (20) foot wide (east/west) platted alley right-of-way (Twenty (20) feet by 164 feet) located within Block 8, Woodruff's Addition (block bounded by E. 7 <sup>th</sup> , E. 8 <sup>th</sup> , College and McLean Streets). ## BACKGROUND CONTINUED

The alley right-of-way is twenty (20) feet wide and 164 feet in length (3,280 sq. ft.). The alley right-of-way is currently undeveloped and grass-covered. All of the abutting properties along the north and south sides of the alley right-of-way are also undeveloped.

The Planning Commission approved the alley right-of-way abandonment as part of the Artspace – PCD development. The approved Artspace PCD will allow for the construction of a 4-story, mixed-use building which will contain 72 living spaces for residents, commercial tenant spaces, multi-use studio space, an art gallery, a community room, outdoor public areas including a rooftop terrace garden and a public porch for gathering. The Artspace PCD development will encompass the entire Block 8, Woodruff's Addition.

The alley right-of-way was dedicated with the original subdivision of Woodruff's Addition to the City of Little Rock. Information from an abstract company notes that there are no reversionary clauses for rights-of-way within this subdivision. Therefore, the abutting property owner will obtain ownership of the alley area after abandonment.

There are no Master Street Plan issues, as the right-of-way is not classified as a collector street or higher.

Abandoning this small alley right-of-way will have no adverse impact on public welfare and safety. The Little Rock Fire Department has expressed no objection to the abandonment request.
