SYNOPSIS	<p>The resolution authorizes the City Manager to purchase four (4)-year warranties for 100 Less-Than-Lethal Electronic Control Devices (Tasers) from Teeco Safety, Inc.</p>	
FISCAL IMPACT	<p>The total cost is \$51,524.30 and will come from Seized Assets Funds.</p>	
RECOMMENDATION	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>

BACKGROUND	<p>The Board previously approved a sole-source ordinance for the purchase of 100 additional Less-Than-Lethal Electronic Control Devices (Tasers) from Teeco Safety, Inc., because it was impractical and unfeasible to bid. The monies for this purchase were made through a short-term financing note issued by the City. It is also necessary to purchase warranties for these devices, which will be paid out of Seized Assets Funds. As a result of the earlier sole-source ordinance, a resolution can authorize this purchase.</p>

If the cost of the warranties, with tax, did not exceed \$50,000, then the purchase could be made without formal Board approval; however, the purchase price does exceed this amount.
