3 **A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER**
4 **INTO AN ANNUAL CONTRACT WITH GOODYEAR COMMERCIAL**
5 **TIRE AND SERVICE CENTER FOR THE PURCHASE OF TRUCK TIRE**
6 **RETREADING SERVICES, IN AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL AMOUNT OF**
7 **ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00),**
8 **FOR THE FLEET SERVICES DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER**
9 **PURPOSES.**

11 **WHEREAS**, the City of Little Rock advertised for bids to establish an APO for the purchase of
12 Truck Tire Retreading Services for the Fleet Services Department; and,

13 **WHEREAS**, Goodyear Commercial Tire and Service Center was the lowest qualified bidder of the
14 three (3) total bids received through formal competitive bidding process;

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**
16 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

17 **Section 1.** The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with
18 Goodyear Commercial Tire and Service Center for the purchase of Truck Tire Retreading Services, in an
19 estimated annual amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00), for the Fleet
20 Services Department.

21 **Section 2.** This annual purchase order is authorized for a period of one (1)-year, with an option to
22 renew each year for up to two (2) additional years.

23 **Section 3.** Funds for this purchase are allocated in the 2015 Fleet Parts Budget.

24 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
25 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
26 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
27 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
28 resolution.

29 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
30 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
