<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Redstone Construction Group, Inc., for Chenal Traffic Island Modifications, Project No. 5-17-ST-225B, Bid No. 972.</p> <p>The amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$190,234.62, which is the base bid amount of \$158,528.85, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the Limited Tax General Obligation Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution No. 14,803.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This project provides the removal or modification of traffic islands on Chenal Parkway at Autumn Road, Embassy Suites Drive and Westhaven Drive. This will result in a longer continuous third through-lane at these locations to improve traffic flow on this busy arterial. Redstone Construction Group, Inc., was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of two (2) bids received for the project.</p>
