**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LARRY HARRIS DBA HARRIS CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED FOUR DOLLARS (\$143,904.00), FOR THE 24<sup>TH</sup> AND 25<sup>TH</sup> STREET SIDEWALKS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, project improvements include sidewalk and curb construction on 24<sup>th</sup> Street and 25<sup>th</sup> Street east of Main and Scott Streets from 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> Street; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Bid Event No. 2588, Larry Harris dba Harris Construction Management was the lowest most responsive, responsible bidder meeting the requested bid requirements of the three (3) bids received; and,

**WHEREAS**, the total cost of the project shall not exceed One Hundred Forty-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Four Dollars (\$143,904.00), which includes a 20% contingency.

**WHEREAS**, funding for the project is from Infrastructure as Economic Development Accounting Unit 108409 Activity S40G673.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1.** The Board of Directors authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Larry Harris dba Harris Construction Management, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Forty-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Four Dollars (\$143,904.00), which includes a 20% contingency, for the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> Street Sidewalks Project.

**Section 2.** Funding for this project is from Infrastructure as Economic Development Accounting Unit 108409 Activity S40G673.

**Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

**Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
