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3 **A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER**  
4 **INTO A CONTRACT WITH DEPAUL USA, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT**  
5 **TO EXCEED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE**  
6 **DOLLARS (\$54,689.00), FOR EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS COVID-19**  
7 **GRANT FUNDING, FOR STREET OUTREACH SERVICES FOR A ONE**  
8 **(1)-YEAR PERIOD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**  
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10 **WHEREAS**, the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, was granted ESG-CV (Emergency Solutions Grant)  
11 Funds made available pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act;  
12 and,

13 **WHEREAS**, the ESG-CV is designed to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus  
14 Pandemic (COVID-19) for individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance;  
15 and,

16 **WHEREAS**, funds will also support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention  
17 activities to mitigate the impacts of COVID-19; and,

18 **WHEREAS**, the City issued a Request for Qualifications dated September 1, 2020, to procure a  
19 service provider for ESG-CV assistance; and,

20 **WHEREAS**, on October 12, 2020, DePaul USA was selected by the Selection Committee to provide  
21 Street Outreach Services in the City in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred  
22 Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$54,689.00) for a one (1)-year term, with the City's option to extend the contract for  
23 one (1) additional year or a portion thereof depending on service needs and the availability of funding  
24 with the right to terminate the agreement upon completion of the grant.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**  
26 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

27 **Section 1.** The Board of Directors hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with  
28 DePaul USA for a one (1)-year term, with the City's option to extend the contract for one (1) additional  
29 year, in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$54,689.00) for  
30 Emergency Solutions Covid-19 Grant (ESG-CV) Funding for Street Outreach Services within the City of  
31 Little Rock, Arkansas.

32 **Section 2.** The funds are available from the City's allocation of ESG-CV Funds from the Arkansas  
33 Department of Human Services.

1       **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
2 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
3 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and  
4 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
5 resolution.

6       **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent  
7 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
