A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH POSITIVE RESULTS LAWN SERVICES, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$88,980.00), FOR CHERRYWOOD COURT DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, it has been deemed appropriate and necessary to analyze and design drainage improvements to replace a collapsed pipe; and,

WHEREAS, project improvements include construction of a junction box, headwall and velocity dissipation devices; and,

WHEREAS, the project will reduce property damage caused by inadequate drainage facilities; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bid Event No. 2648, Positive Results Law Services, Inc. was the lowest most responsive, responsible bidder meeting the requested bid requirements of the three (3) bids received;

WHEREAS, the total cost for this contract shall not exceed Eighty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty and 00/100 Dollars (\$88,980.00) which is the base bid amount of Seventy Four Thousand One Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$74,150.00) plus twenty percent (20%) contingencies, if needed;

WHEREAS, funding for the project is from the 2022 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution 15,968 (May 2, 2023) with funds available from Account Activity B6D057D; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Positive Results Lawn Service, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Eighty Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty and 00/100 Dollars (\$88,980.00), which is the base bid amount of Seventy Four Thousand, One Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$74,150.00) plus 20% contingencies.

Section 2. Funding for this project is from the 2022 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution 15,968 (May 2, 2023). Account Activity B6D057D.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

1 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
2 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
