<p>SYNOPSIS</p> <p>FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>To authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with SHI, Inc., for the renewal of the Building Application System provided by Quickbase, Inc., for the Department of Emergency Communications.</p> <p>The total amount is not to exceed \$70,903.88, which includes the cost for all users at \$39,726.62 and the annual service package of \$31,177.26. Funds for this purchase are available in the 9-1-1 Wireless Account No. 220512.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The Department of Emergency Communications obtained a new Business Application System provided by Quickbase, Inc., which allows the Department to merge its business/administrative needs with the daily workflow functions in a seamless manner.</p> <p>As the 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Center continues to transition to a stand-alone center, it has been observed that there is a need to streamline the workflow, reorganize records within the department, and create an environment that allows the employees to independently function and held accountable.</p>

Employees will be allowed to have independent access to the application in order to safely and securely maintain their own employee matters such as; clocking in and out, signing up for overtime shifts, requesting time off, etc. This will make it easier to manage and monitor the employees' functions while providing a paperless concept in the workflow.
