SYNOPSIS	The Little Rock Police Department is requesting approval to purchase a new Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD) System and enter into a contract with Motorola, the selected as a result of a formal request for proposals through Bid No. 17186-R.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The cost of exceed \$3,764,303 is for the complete CAD System (excluding mobile hardware) and a total of five (5) years of maintenance support. The estimated taxes total \$269,081, and a 20% contingency fee is included due to the complex nature of the software and hardware installation and deployment. The total amount, including the above listed taxes and contingency fee, is not to exceed \$4,786,244. Funding will be available through a short-term financing note to be issued in 2019.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	Bid No. 17186-R was issued for the purchase, installation, and deployment of a new Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) System. A selection committee was formed and reviewed technical proposals, attended on-site demonstrations and conducted site visits for each of the prospective CAD vendors. After the evaluation process, the selection committee determined Motorola's PremierOne CAD and PremierOne Mobile would be the best option for the City.
