<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p>	<p>To authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Doyne Construction Company for the Track and Berm project at LRPD Training.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>The current backstop (berm) to Little Rock Police Department’s Shotgun Range, located at the Training Division, is being replaced by a new rubberized backstop, which was approved by the Board of Directors. In order to install this new backstop, the area needs to be prepared. This process includes removing a portion of the old backstop and pouring a fortified concrete slab for the backstop to sit on. The bid process was conducted, and it was recommended that Doyne Construction be awarded the contract. During this time, Doyne Construction also bid on repairing and resurfacing the current running track, which is becoming dangerous to use due to large holes and surface crack.</p>
