<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>Authorizes the transfer of the City’s share of project funds to the USACOE for the design, environmental clearance, and construction of the Stump Creek project.</p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The City of Little Rock is in receipt of a request from the USACOE to transfer One Million, Two Hundred Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and 00/100, (\$1,200,565.00) into an account from which the Government can withdraw funds to cover the non-Federal cost share of the project. Funding is from Special Project 108409 S40G672 in the amount of \$1,000,000 and \$200,565.00 from the Limited Tax General Obligation Capital Improvement Bonds, as approved by Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,968 (May 2, 2023), Account No. 332409 B2D051D.</p>

<p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>This project will provide for the clearing and removal of debris and channel improvements for Stump Creek east of Reck Road and south of Arehart Drive to reduce the frequency and severity of flooding, which negatively affects area residents and property. The USACOE will undertake the design, environmental clearance, and construction of the project.</p>
