<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Garver, LLC, for the Infrastructure Phase 2 Priority Study, Bid No. 1063.</p> <p>Funding for this contract is in an amount not to exceed \$99,562.00, and is available from the Street Fund Budget.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This resolution will authorize a new contract for Engineering Services to continue work that began in 2019, to develop a system to prioritize the many project request and needs in the city for Capital Improvement Projects for streets, drainage and pedestrian transportation. Phase 1 of study developed and ranked scoring criteria based on input from staff and public outreach efforts. This phase of the study will develop scoring guidelines, incorporate other factors in the criteria such as cost, project duration, and number of beneficiaries and begin development of a potential list of future projects for consideration. Similar to Phase 1, this phase of the work includes several stakeholder meetings to gather a broad range of public input.</p>
