<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>An ordinance to amend Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance No. 22,368 (January 23, 2024), to authorize the City Manager to amend the services agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc., to increase the Sole-Source Contract amount for Radio Infrastructure utilized by the City’s Emergency Communications Department.</p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>Increase the amount from \$227,422.42 to \$238,781.88. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the Emergency Communications Department’s 911 Fund, Account No. 220512.</p>	
<p>RECOMMENDATION</p>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>The LRPD successfully utilized the maintenance plan in the contract for the Radio Infrastructure System, which includes maintenance on dispatch center consoles, Mach Alert hardware, microwave links, and the radio IP logger which is utilized by the Emergency Communications Department. When exercising the option to extend the contract, it was determined that it was necessary to upgrade the service agreement which resulted in a higher cost than allowed by Ordinance No. 22,368.</p>
