| SYNOPSIS   | As a regulatory requirement, a public hearing must be conducted regarding proposed amendments to the Consolidated Plan, Action Plan, and sources and uses of 2022 CDBG, HOME, and HOPWA funding, according to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.  |                                     |
| FISCAL IMPACT  | The city will include Facility-Based Housing / Capital Development and Homebuyer Assistance as activities in the 2021-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2022 Action Plan. A reallocation of CDBG funds from previous allocation of \$5,965.50 will increase the 2022 funding to \$1,539,483.50 and be an addition to owner-occupied rehabilitation. A reallocation of HOME funds from previous allocation of 200,000.00 will increase the 2022 funding to \$1,480,069.27 and be an addition for Homebuyer Assistance. A reallocation of 2022 HOPWA funds will add \$550,000 to Facility-Based Housing/Capital Development |                                     |

and decrease Project Sponsor Administration by 65,224.74 and decrease Housing Assistance and Related Supportive Services by \$484,775.26.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On December 21, 2021, the City of Little Rock Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 15,599 approving sources and uses of 2022 CDBG, HOME and HOPWA Funds. On June 7, 2022, the City of Little Rock Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 15,703 approving the amended sources and uses of 2022 CDBG, HOME, and HOPWA Funds.

Consistent with the City's adopted Citizen Participation Plan, the Consolidated Planning Committee recommended the inclusion of activities Facility-Based Housing/Capital Development and Homebuyer Assistance to the 2021-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2022 Annual Action Plan as well as the amended sources and uses of the City's 2022 Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Funds, Home Investment Partnerships Program, and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS.
