

- 1. Texas Department of Information Resources (“Texas DIR”); and
- m. The Interlocal Purchasing System (“TIPS”).

Section 2. Any limitation on any of these cooperative purchasing contracts shall be imposed by the City’s Chief Financial Officer or his designee.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency, including but not limited to, Little Rock, Ark., Resolutions 12,463 (March 6, 2007), 13,252 (January 3, 2011), 13,532 (July 17, 2012), 14,812 (June 19, 2018), 15,006 (June 4, 2019), 15,572 (December 7, 2021), 15,573 (December 7, 2021), 15,714 (June 21, 2022), 15,877 (February 7, 2023), 16,281 (April 2, 2024), 16,413 (September 3, 2024).
