<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>To authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with G &amp; W Diesel for the refurbishing of one (1) 2003 Pierce Dash Tiller Truck for the Little Rock Fire Department (Truck 7 (Unit 03D099) Station 7: Markham Street and Elm Street).</p> <p>The total cost for the repair is \$612,387.50 and funds are allocated in a Little Rock Fire Department Short-Term Note Account No. 325519-F449003. A 10% contingency amount of \$61,238.75 is reserved for any unforeseen fees and/or parts and labor.</p> <p>Approval of the ordinance.</p> <p>G &amp; W Diesel is the only authorized Pierce dealer in Central Arkansas. The refurbishment process is determined to be a viable alternative to purchases of new vehicles for front-line fire unit assignment. A contingency plan allows for any unforeseen fees and/or parts and labor.</p>
