(formerly ShotSpotter, Inc.), for the renewal of the wide-area gunshot detection service and addition of case builder software for the Little Rock Police Department.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>In addition to real-time gunfire detection, integrating CaseBuilder as an intelligence-gathering database enhances the department’s ability to manage and analyze critical data from criminal investigations. CaseBuilder centralizes evidence, facilitates collaboration, and provides tools to organize and connect investigative findings, ensuring more effective follow-up during investigations.</p>
