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16	and authorized the Mayor to execute a sole source agreement with Locality Media, Inc. for records		
17	management; and,		
18	WHEREAS, Locality Media, Inc. provides the First Due Software which will enable LRFD to, among		
19	other things, (1) gather and maintain information regarding fire systems, hydrants, hazardous materials		
20	occupancies, and other data; (2) to perform pre-incident mapping using GPS and other data; (3) to better		
21	create and maintain its inspections of records and documents; and (4) to manage its data concerning permits;		
22	and,		
23	WHEREAS, LRFD requests an Agreement with Locality Media, Inc. to provide software for incident		
24	reporting and records management system for one (1) year with an option to renew the contract for two (2)		
25	additional one (1) year extensions after the initial term; and,		
26	WHEREAS, the total cost of the addition of Locality Media, Inc.'s records management software is		
27	Sixty-Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-Eight and 13/100 Dollars (\$67,528.13).
