15	WHEREAS, after issuing Requests for Proposal (RFP) Bid No. 2671 - Positive Prevention		
16	Programs, ages six (6) - twelve (12), and;		
17	WHEREAS, A Review Committee met to evaluate the qualifications and responses of the various non-		
18	profit, and faith-based organizations, of which applicants met the minimum scores for funding		
19	consideration; and,		
20	WHEREAS, on Wednesday, December 4, 2024, at the monthly meeting of the Commission for		
21	Children, Youth and Families, the Commission reviewed the recommendations and endorsed the following		
22	recommendations for approval; and,		
23	WHEREAS, upon the formal adoption of this resolution, any negotiation processes will begin with ar		
24	intent to execute contracts with each of the organizations.		
25	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
26	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
27	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a one (1)-year contract with		
28	OUR HOUSE to provide Positive Prevention Programs in 2025, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred		
<u> 2</u> 9	Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per contracted Positive Prevention Program.		
30	Section 2. Funds for these programs are available in the 2025 Budget of the Community		
31	Programs Department, Account No.108159		
32	Section 3. The term for each contract listed in Section 1 of this resolution shall be for a		
33	period no longer than a calendar year of twelve (12) months, and will operate between January		

1	1, 2025, through December 31, 2025, with the final report due January 31, 2026, with an		
2	understanding that the City ratifies, accepts, and will compensate any work done between		
3	January I, 2025, and the effective date of the approved contract.		
4	Section 4. All payments are conditioned upon entry into contracts for services that are in a		
5	form acceptable to the City Attorney; further, nothing in this resolution prevents the City from		
6	being able to offer similar services to any vendor during 2025 if, in its sole discretion, it decides		
7	to do so.		
8	Section 5. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause,		
9	phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional,		
10	such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which		
11	shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or		
12	unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.		
13	Section 6. Repealer. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are		
14	inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such		
15	inconsistency.
